




Activities / Fire District January 2015/2016




Call Type January 2015/2016




Call Type February 2015/2016

WHEREAS, the intersection of Sand Creek Road with Arkansas Road in rural Franklin County, Kansas, is formed by the convergence of a minor east-west road *viz.* Sand Creek Road, and a minor north-south road, *viz.* Arkansas Road; and

WHEREAS, K.S.A. 8-2002, authorizes local authorities, including counties, to designate any highway as a through highway or designate any intersection or junction of roadways as a stop or yield intersection or junction, and

WHEREAS, K.S.A. 8-2008, authorizes local authorities to erect and maintain stop signs, yield signs, or other official traffic-control devices upon highways under their jurisdictions; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to K.S.A. 8-2003, Section 2B-5, Number 1, of the *Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices*, provides for the placement of a stop sign where the application of the normal right-of-way is unduly hazardous; and

IT IS THEREFORE recommended that stop signs for eastbound and westbound traffic on Sand Creek Road be installed at the intersection of Sand Creek Road and Arkansas Road.

THAT the Board of County Commissioners hereby directs that a stop signs for eastbound and westbound traffic on Sand Creek Road be installed at the intersection of Sand Creek Road and Arkansas Road.
