A RESOLUTION TO VACATE A PORTION OF ARKANSAS ROAD NORTH OF K-31 IN FRANKLIN COUNTY,
KANSAS

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Commission authorized notice of proposed vacation of a portion of Arkansas Road North of K-31 described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the on the Section Line between Section 13, T19S, R17E and Section 14, T19S, R17S at the North right-of-way of K-31 Highway thence North to the terminus of the aforesaid road.

WHEREAS, the Notice of Public Hearing was published in the official county newspaper on August 8, 2018, and

WHEREAS, notice of the proposed vacation was mailed by certified mail, return receipt requested, to all landowners of record as required by K.S.A. 68-102 notifying said landowners of the proposed vacation and of their right to protest said vacation; and,

WHEREAS, a hearing was held on August 8, 2018 for anyone wishing to protest the vacation of said particular road; and,

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED
BY
THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY

That the following road is not a public utility by reason of neglect, non-use, or inconvenience and that said road has become practically impassable and the necessity for said road as a public utility does not justify the expenditure of the necessary funds to repair said road or put the same in condition for public travel and therefore said road is hereby vacated as follows:

Beginning at a point on the on the Section Line between Section 13, T19S, R17E and Section 14, T19S, R17S at the North right-of-way of K-31 Highway thence North to the terminus of the aforesaid road.

This Resolution shall be in full force and effect following its passage by the Board of County Commissioners and its subsequent publication in the official county newspaper.

WHEREUPON, the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Kansas, passes and adopts this Resolution in regular session, at its chambers in Ottawa, Franklin County, Kansas, this 8th day of August 2018.
