Chair Howard called the study session to order at 8:30a.m.

All Commissioners present except Commissioner Harris.

Erin Laurie, Heath Educator with the Franklin County Health Department, gave an update on the Healthy Communities Initiative. She also announced that Franklin County was awarded the Pathways Grant from Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Kansas.

Sheila Robertson, Food Policy Council Chair, highlighted some initiatives like the newly opened Farmer's Market in Pomona on Saturdays and a plan to hold a design contest for bike racks for the community with subsequent build by a local business. The Food Policy Council also was awarded a planning grant recently.

Jon Holmes, County Administrator, discussed possibly moving the 911 Dispatch Center under the direction of the Emergency Management Department instead of the Sherriff's Department. Jeff Richards, Sheriff and Alan Radcliffe, Emergency Management Director were present to answer questions from the Commissioners.

There was a consensus of the Commissioners to move forward with the transfer of the 911 Dispatch Center from the Sherriff, Jeff Richards to the Emergency Management Department, Alan Radcliffe, Director.
