BOARD OF FRANKLIN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

Meeting Location: Franklin County Annex Building Commission Chambers

Chair Howard called the meeting to order at 8:30a.m.

Roll call: Chair Richard Howard present, Vice Chair Ianne Dickinson present, Commissioner Donald Stottlemire present, Commissioner Colton Waymire present, Commissioner Roy C. Dunn present.

Chair Howard asked all in attendance to stand and join him in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Invocation was led by Commissioner Ianne Dickinson.

Public Comment: Norman Wooge, 3790 Pawnee Rd, Ottawa- discussed building trust with the citizens of the county. Trust has been destroyed in the past.

Commissioner Dickinson moved and Commissioner Waymire seconded to approve the consent agenda as follows: minutes from the meeting on January 16, 2019 and tax change orders in the amount of \$353.40. All voted "Yes".

Derek Brown, County Administrator, discussed the 2019 tax sale. Approximately 120 properties are tax sale eligible with another 27 properties that are eligible but are in the payment plan and currently making payments. Properties must be four years delinquent to be considered tax sale eligible. Properties that are delinquent from 2013, 2014 and the housing development Coves are being considered for this tax sale.

The Commissioners were supportive of moving forward with the 2019 tax sale. They would like to talk to the treasurer about the payment plan and see a list of those properties.

Derek Brown, County Administrator, discussed the county's trash service and the price increases that have happened over the last six months. The price was increased around June, and the company sold near the end of the year. The price was increased again after the company was sold. The county has 9 locations that trash is collected and picked up. The Commissioners supported getting bids since the trash service bills have increased from \$425.72 to \$2,272.85 over the last six months.

Staff reports were given by Derek Brown, County Administrator and David Lee, Public Works Director.

Commissioner Waymire moved and Commissioner Dickinson seconded to adjourn the meeting at 9:31a.m. All voted "yes".
