BOARD OF FRANKLIN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

Meeting Location: Franklin County Annex Building Commission Chambers

Chair Dunn called the meeting to order at 8:30a.m.

Roll call: Chair Roy C. Dunn present, Vice Chair Ianne Dickinson present, Commissioner Donald Stottlemire present, Commissioner Rod Harris present, Commissioner Colton Waymire present.

Chair Dunn asked all in attendance to stand and join him in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Invocation was led by Jeremiah Walters, Hope Anthem Church, Ottawa.

Chair Dunn read the proposed Proclamation to designate October as Domestic Violence Awareness Month. Commissioner Dickinson moved and Commissioner Stottlemire seconded to adopt Proclamation 22-04 to designate October as Domestic Violence Awareness Month. All voted "yes".

Gabrielle Neal was present to accept the Proclamation and talk about the events planned for Domestic Violence Awareness Month.

Public Comment: Norman Wooge, 3790 Pawnee Rd, Ottawa- discussed methane gas rising from the landfill in Douglas County and wanted to make sure that the expansion in Franklin County doesn't result in the same.

Commissioner Waymire moved and Commissioner Harris seconded to approve the consent agenda as follows: minutes from the meeting on September 21, 2022 and an easement for Brady Enterprises LLC. All voted "yes".

Janet Paddock, County Clerk, discussed ten properties proposed to be entered into the Neighborhood Revitalization Program. The proposed properties, three new residential, six residential remodel, and one commercial project, have all been approved by the NRP committee and need to be approved by the governing bodies prior to project completion. Once completed, they will be entered into the program to start receiving the rebate according to the program guidelines.

Commissioner Stottlemire moved and Commissioner Dickinson seconded to approve the proposed properties into the Neighborhood Revitalization Program as each property meets the program requirements. All voted "yes".

Staff reports were given by Jeff Richards, Sheriff and W. David Lee, Public Works Director.

Commissioner Harris moved and Commissioner Waymire seconded to adjourn the meeting at 8:51a.m. All voted "yes".
