

# I HAVE RECEIVED THE COVID-19 VACCINE, NOW WHAT?

Individuals are considered FULLY VACCINATED 2 weeks after their 2nd dose (Moderna) | only dose (J & J)

It is still important to take steps to protect yourself and others. By recommendations from the CDC, vaccinated individuals should continue to take the following precautions; wear a mask, stay at least 6 feet apart and avoid crowds or poorly ventilated spaces. These precautions should be taken,

- When in public
- When gathering with unvaccinated people from more than one household
- When visiting with a person with increased risk of severe illness or death from COVID-19

## 5 Reasons to Continue Mask Wearing

1. No vaccine provides 100% protection.
2. Vaccines do not provide immediate protection.
3. Those who have been vaccinated can still be asymptomatic spreaders.
4. Its important to protect those with compromised immune systems and those that can't be vaccinated.
5. Masks protect against any strain of the coronavirus, in spite of genetic mutations.

*The best hope for ending the pandemic is to combine masks, physical distancing, and vaccines. The three approaches work best as a team.*
