## BOARD OF FRANKLIN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS REORGANIZATION MEETING

Meeting Location: Franklin County Annex Building Commission Chambers

Chair Dunn called the meeting to order at 8:30a.m.

Roll call: Chair Roy C. Dunn present, Vice Chair Ianne Dickinson present, Commissioner Donald Stottlemire present, Commissioner Rod Harris absent, Commissioner Colton Waymire present.

Chair Dunn asked all in attendance to stand and join him in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Chair Dunn adjourned the current commission at 8:31a.m.

Janet Paddock, County Clerk, administered the oath of office to Colton Waymire, 1<sup>st</sup> District County Commissioner; Ianne Dickinson, 4<sup>th</sup> District County Commissioner; and Donald Stottlemire, 5<sup>th</sup> District County Commissioner.

Commissioner Dunn reconvened the new session of the Franklin County Board of Commissioners.

All commissioners present.

Commissioner Stottlemire nominated Commissioner Dickinson as the Chairperson. Commissioner Dickinson said she would accept.

No other nominations were made.

Commissioner Stottlemire moved and Commissioner Dunn seconded to elect Commissioner Dickinson as the Chairperson for the 2023 session. All voted "yes".

Commissioner Harris nominated Commissioner Waymire as the Vice Chair of the Commission. Commissioner Waymire nominated Commissioner Harris as the Vice Chair of the Commission. Commissioner Dunn nominated Commissioner Stottlemire as the Vice Chair of the Commission.

Commissioner Harris said he would like to wait one more year before taking a leadership role. Commissioner Stottlemire said his plate is too full and would rather not. Commissioner Waymire said he would accept.

Commissioner Harris moved and Commissioner Stottlemire seconded to elect Commissioner Waymire as the Vice Chair of the Commission for the 2023 session. All voted "yes".

Commissioner Stottlemire moved and Commissioner Harris seconded to keep the meeting dates and times the same as the previous year: regular meetings on Wednesday mornings at 8:30a.m. and study sessions to be every other Monday beginning on January 23, 2023. All voted "yes".
