**RESOLUTION 13 - 20**

**A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A POLICY FOR THE ADDITION OF  
NAMES TO THE FRANKLIN COUNTY VETERAN'S MEMORIAL WALL**

WHEREAS, K.S.A. 19-101, provides that a County may exercise the powers of home rule to determine its local affairs and government authorization under the provisions of K.S.A. 19-101a; and

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners recognizes the importance to the citizens of Franklin County to preserve its history and honor the men and women of Franklin County that have lost their lives in service to their country; and

WHEREAS, The Franklin County Veteran's Memorial was dedicated to and given to the Franklin County Commission on May 1, 2000 in honor of the men and women that have served and that will serve in the future; and

WHEREAS, The Franklin County Commission recognizes the ongoing responsibility and is the body responsible for approving the future addition of names to the Memorial.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED  
BY  
THE BOARD OF FRANKLIN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS,**

That the following resolution establishes the official policy of Franklin County in regard to the addition of names to the Franklin County Veteran's Memorial.

- I. An individual who wishes to have a name added to the Veteran's Memorial shall submit the request to the Franklin County Administration Office. The Franklin County Administrator shall research the request and present the request to the Franklin County Board of County Commissioners for consideration.
- II. Eligibility requirements are as follows: Any Franklin County resident or person inducted/enlisted in Franklin County, who was killed in combat or lost their life as the result of a catastrophic event to/from a combat area may have their names added to the Memorial. Franklin County resident includes any service member that attended school at any time in Franklin County.

This Resolution shall be in full force and effect following its adoption.
