**A RESOLUTION REPEALING RESOLUTION 97-15**

**WHEREAS**, K.S.A. 19-101, provides that a county may exercise the powers of home rule to determine its local affairs including the oversight of county property; and

**WHEREAS**, in Franklin County Resolution 97-15 the Board of County Commissioners made it a crime of criminal trespass pursuant to K.S.A. 21-3721 for unauthorized persons to enter or remain upon the Franklin County Annex premises between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners finds that the conditions that led to the adoption of Franklin County Resolution 97-15, specifically loitering, littering and vandalism are no longer a problem and it is appropriate to repeal Franklin County Resolution 97-15.

Franklin County Resolution 97-15 is no longer necessary and it is repealed effective immediately.
