A RESOLUTION APPOINTING A SPECIAL DEPUTY CORONER FOR THE FOURTH
JUDICIAL DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the Fourth Judicial District is comprised of Franklin, Osage, Anderson, and Coffey; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to K.S.A. 22a-226, the Board of County Commissioners of the county with the largest population shall appoint a District Coroner for the district; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Willard B. Ransom is the appointed District Coroner for the Fourth Judicial District; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to K.S.A. 22a-226 the District Coroner may appoint special deputy coroners when the District Coroner is unable to appoint a qualified deputy coroner; and

WHEREAS, the District Coroner is unable to appoint a qualified deputy coroner in Anderson County; and

WHEREAS, the District Coroner appoints Don Nungessor to act as Special Deputy Coroner for a period of one year on until a qualified deputy coroner may be appointed commencing on January 1, 2014; and

WHEREAS, Don Nungessor is currently serving as a special deputy coroner and his current term shall continue until the end of 2013.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, KANSAS**

That Don Nungessor is hereby appointed to serve as a Special Deputy Coroner for a period of one year commencing on January 1, 2014. The current term he is serving as Special Deputy Coroner shall expire at the end of 2013. This new appointment shall expire at the end of 2014 or upon the appointment of a qualified deputy coroner, whichever shall occur first.

This Resolution shall be and become effective upon adoption.
