**A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A TRAINING CENTER FEE SCHEDULE FOR THE FRANKLIN
COUNTY EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE**

WHEREAS, K.S.A. 19-101, provides that a county may exercise the powers of home rule to determine its local affairs and government as authorized under the provisions of K.S.A. 19-101a; and

WHEREAS, K.S.A. 65-6101 et. seq. authorizes local municipalities to establish and operate emergency medical services and to establish and collect charges for emergency medical services; and

WHEREAS, Franklin County has established and provides emergency medical services for Franklin County, Kansas; and

WHEREAS, Franklin County EMS is a American Heart Association training center; and

WHEREAS, American Heart Association has changed the rules so that only training centers can order training products; and

WHEREAS, Franklin County EMS must follow the changes set by the American Heart Association; and

WHEREAS, Franklin County EMS must set a fee schedule to charge the American Heart Association sites that report to Franklin County EMS and for supplies; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners believes that it is in the best interest of Franklin County to adopt a fee schedule effective March 13, 2013.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY
THE BOARD OF FRANKLIN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS,**

That the following resolution shall establish the fee schedule for Franklin County Emergency Medical Services effective March 13, 2013:
